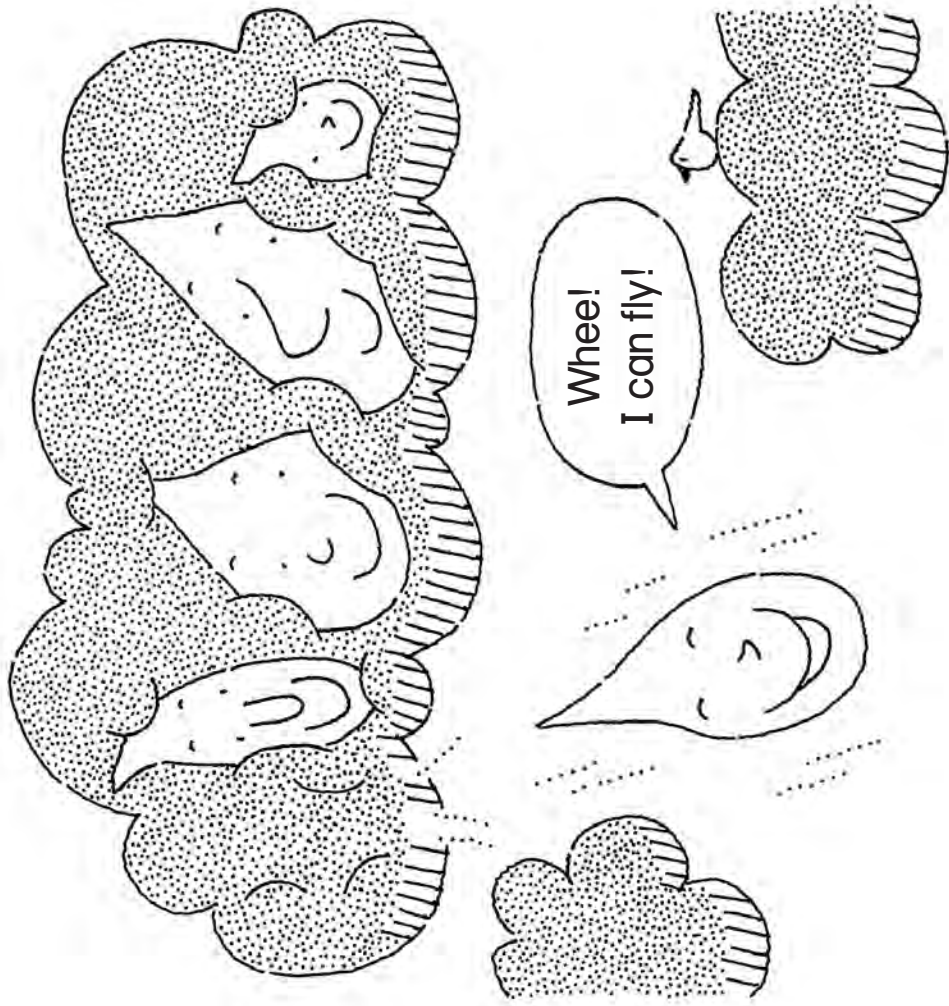
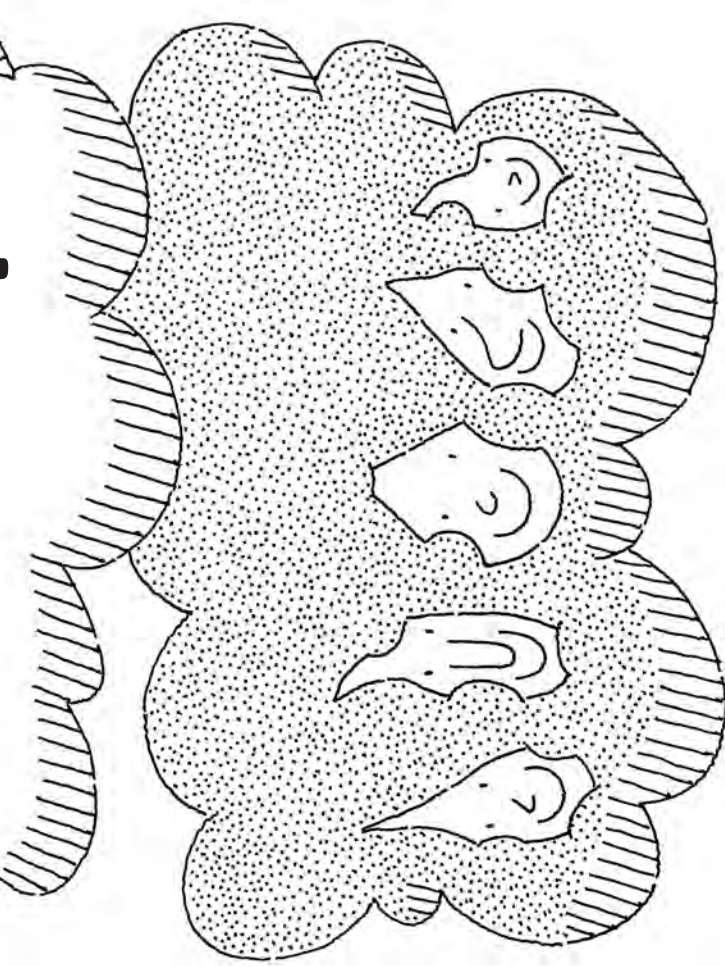


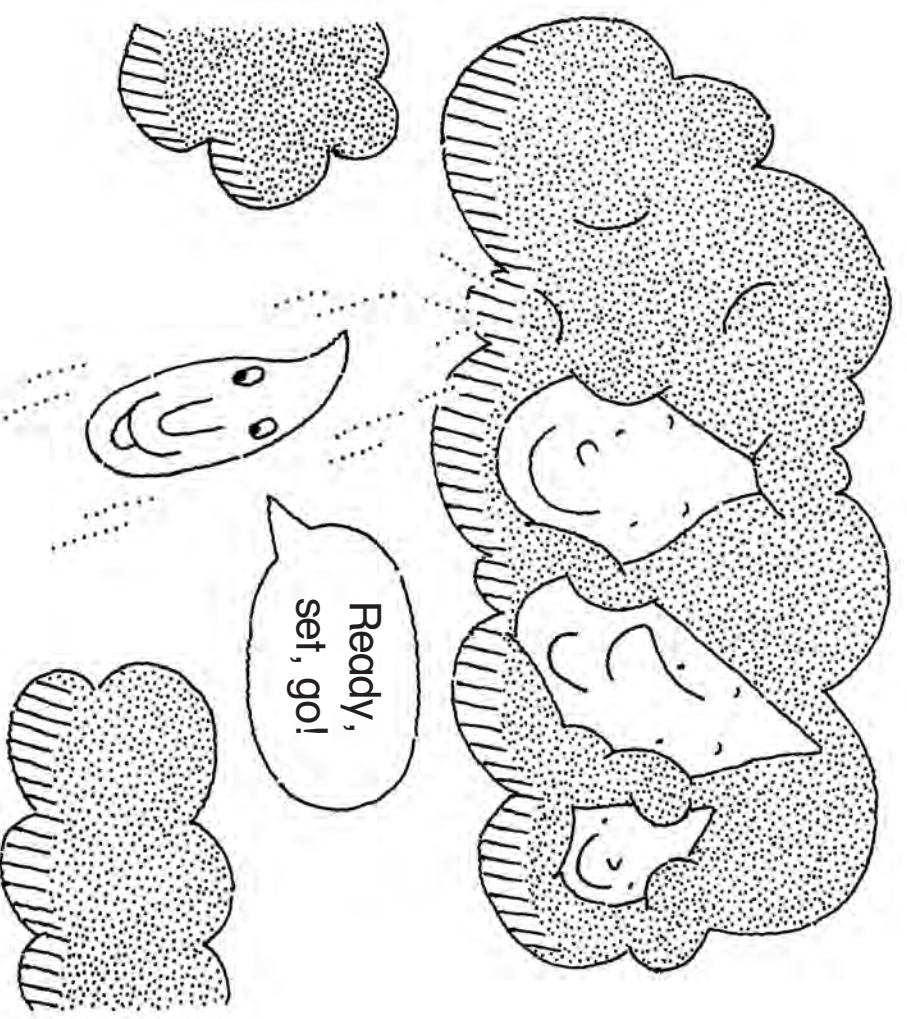
Five Little Raindrops



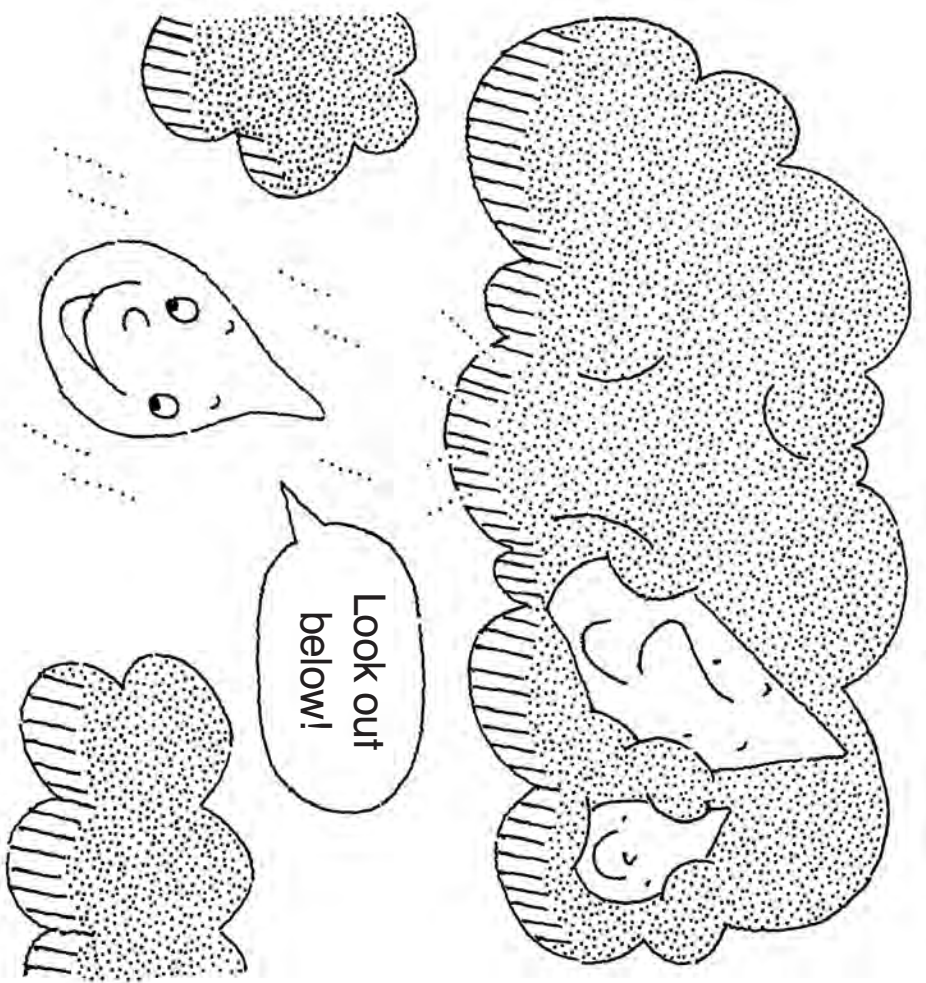
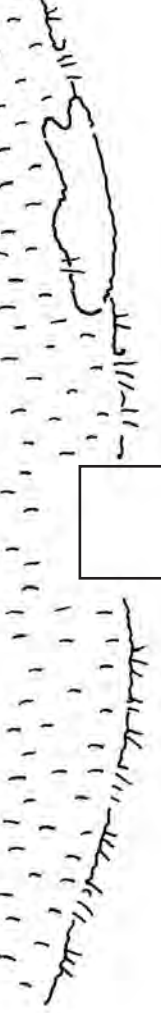
Five little raindrops

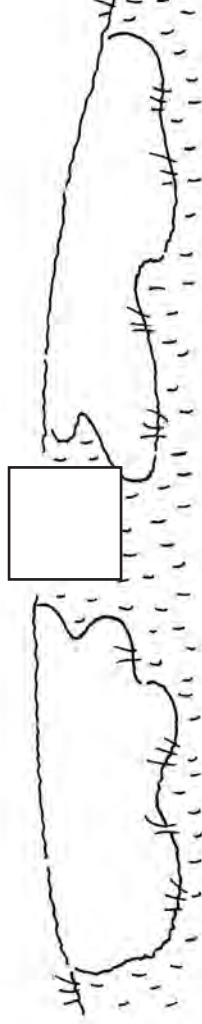
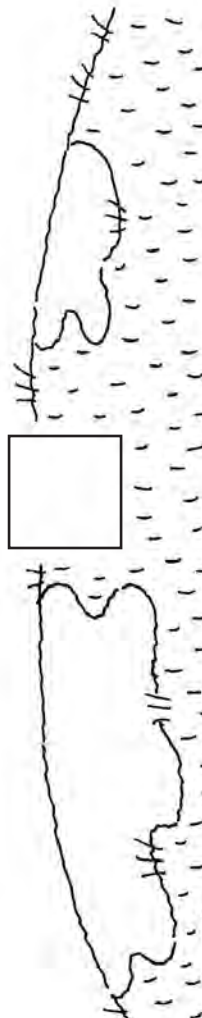




The fourth one said,

How to Make the Mini-Book

Copy the reproducible patterns for this mini-book. Distribute the patterns to children and have them assemble their mini-book according to the directions below. After they correctly order and number the pages, help children stack and staple the pages together behind the cover.

Five-Page Mini-Book Illustrations and Text

This mini-book has words and pictures on every page. Children use both textual and visual clues to sequence the pages.

1. After distributing the pages to children, point out that the pages have both pictures and text.
2. Offer guidance as children look for clues in the illustrations and text that will help them sequence the pages.
3. After children correctly order the pages, have them fill in the page numbers.

Before You Start

The mini-book pages are sequenced in the correct order in this resource. To distribute the pages in random order, copy a class supply of the mini-book pages and use a paper cutter to cut the pages apart. You can then stack the pages for each mini-book in random order before distributing them to children.
